To the Commission Panel,

We are writing as residents of Aspen Park in the RM of Armstrong to formally object to the proposed wastewater lagoon for the Harbour Colony development. My primary concerns are:

1. **Hydrological Sensitivity:** The proposed site is located in a known flood-prone area. High-water events in the Interlake (such as 2022) pose a significant risk of lagoon overflow, which would discharge untreated effluent directly into local watersheds.
2. **Impact on Lake Winnipeg:** Any nutrient runoff (phosphorus and nitrogen) from this site will ultimately reach Lake Winnipeg via Willow Creek. The current proposal does not adequately address the cumulative impact of this lagoon alongside the industrial poultry operation.
3. **Water Reservoir Protection:** I am concerned about the potential for groundwater contamination affecting local wells and regional water reservoirs that serve the RM of Armstrong and RM of Gimli.

I request that the Commission recommend a full environmental impact study that considers the lagoon and the 140,000-bird poultry farm as a single combined project, rather than individual applications.
