THE FIRST NATION PEOPLES OF SOUTH INDIAN LAKE
(hereafter "SIL");

THE NELSON HOUSE FIRST NATION
(hereafter "NHFN");

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF CANADA,
as represented by the Minister of Indian Affairs and
Northern Development
(hereafter "Canada");

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF MANITOBA
as represented by the Minister of Northern Affairs
(hereafter "Manitoba")

WHEREAS SIL have historically been regarded as members of NHFN;

AND WHEREAS SIL have been living at the present site of Community of South Indian Lake, in Manitoba, since time immemorial;

AND WHEREAS SIL have always maintained a community apart from NHFN;

AND WHEREAS SIL has declared their intentions to seek to be recognised by Canada as a "band" within the meaning of the Indian Act and to further have certain lands in and around the community of South Indian Lake set apart by Canada as a "reserve" within the meaning of the Indian Act for their use and benefit;

AND WHEREAS NHFN has ratified and fully supports the position of SIL;

AND WHEREAS SIL, by and through Community Association of South Indian Lake Inc., entered into an agreement with Manitoba Hydro Electric Board and Manitoba as a consequence of the adverse impacts of hydro electric development of the Churchill River system and the attendant regulation of Lake Winnipeg (hereafter "the Settlement Agreement");

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to paragraph 4.01 of the Settlement Agreement (but subject to the conditions therein provided), Manitoba undertook to set aside approximately 8,500 acres of provincial Crown land (including inter alia the townsite of the Community of South Indian Lake) as land dedicated for the use and benefit of the Community of South Indian Lake;

AND WHEREAS Manitoba further undertook to subsequently transfer administration and control of such lands (hereafter "the Compensation Lands") to Canada, free and clear of all encumbrances and inclusive of mines and minerals, upon Canada confirming that it is prepared to recommend to the Governor-in-Council that such lands be set apart as "reserve" within the meaning of the Indian Act.

AND WHEREAS it is the intention of Canada, with the support of NHFN, to undertake a process leading to a recommendation to the Governor-in-Council that SIL be recognised as a "band" within the meaning of the Indian Act;

AND WHEREAS it is further the intention fo Canada to recommend to the Governor-in-Council that, upon SIL being recognised as a "band" and upon the transfer of administration and control by Manitoba to Canada of the Compensation Lands, but provided that such lands are acceptable to SIL and to Canada, the Compensation Lands be set apart as a "reserve" within the meaning of the Indian Act;

NOW THEREFORE the parties agree to exercise their best efforts to ensure the success of a process leading to:

- (a) the recognition of SIL as a "band" within the meaning of the Indian Act; and
- (b) the setting apart of the Compensation Lands as a "reserve" within the meaning of the Indian Act for the use and benefit of SIL

which process shall be pursued in an expeditious manner and shall commence *within 90 days of the date hereof.* *24*

- Whereas: Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation (hereinafter the "Cree Nation") has rights under Treaty # 5 including rights to receive lands; and
- Whereas: The Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation has not received the full amount of land to which we are entitled under the terms of the said treaty, as recognized in the Manitoba Treaty Land Entitlement Framework Agreement (hereinafter the "Framework Agreement") signed by Canada, the Province of Manitoba and the Treaty Land Entitlement Committee of Manitoba; and
- Whereas: The Treaty Entitlement Agreement (TEA) sets out the process for the selection of up to 79,435 acres of land to be converted to reserve status;
- Whereas: The Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation agreed to a division of lands of the TEA and will transfer (22.25%) 17,674.29 acres for the use and benefit of O-Pipon-Na-piwin Cree Nation; on the understanding that additional lands may be transferred once the Manitoba easements calculations are completed pursuant to the terms of the TEA.
- Whereas: Until the O-Pipon-Na-piwin Cree Nation is recognized as a "New Band" within the meaning of the Indian Act, the O-Pipon-Na-piwin Cree Nation is unable to independently confirm their crown land selections;
- Whereas: The Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation has agreed to confirm Crown Land selections made by O-Pipon-Na-piwin Cree Nation as per the Framework Agreement and TEA; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That on behalf of the O-Pipon-Na-Piwin Cree Nation, the Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation selects the following parcels of Crown land in partial fulfillment of the Framework Agreement and TEA:

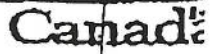

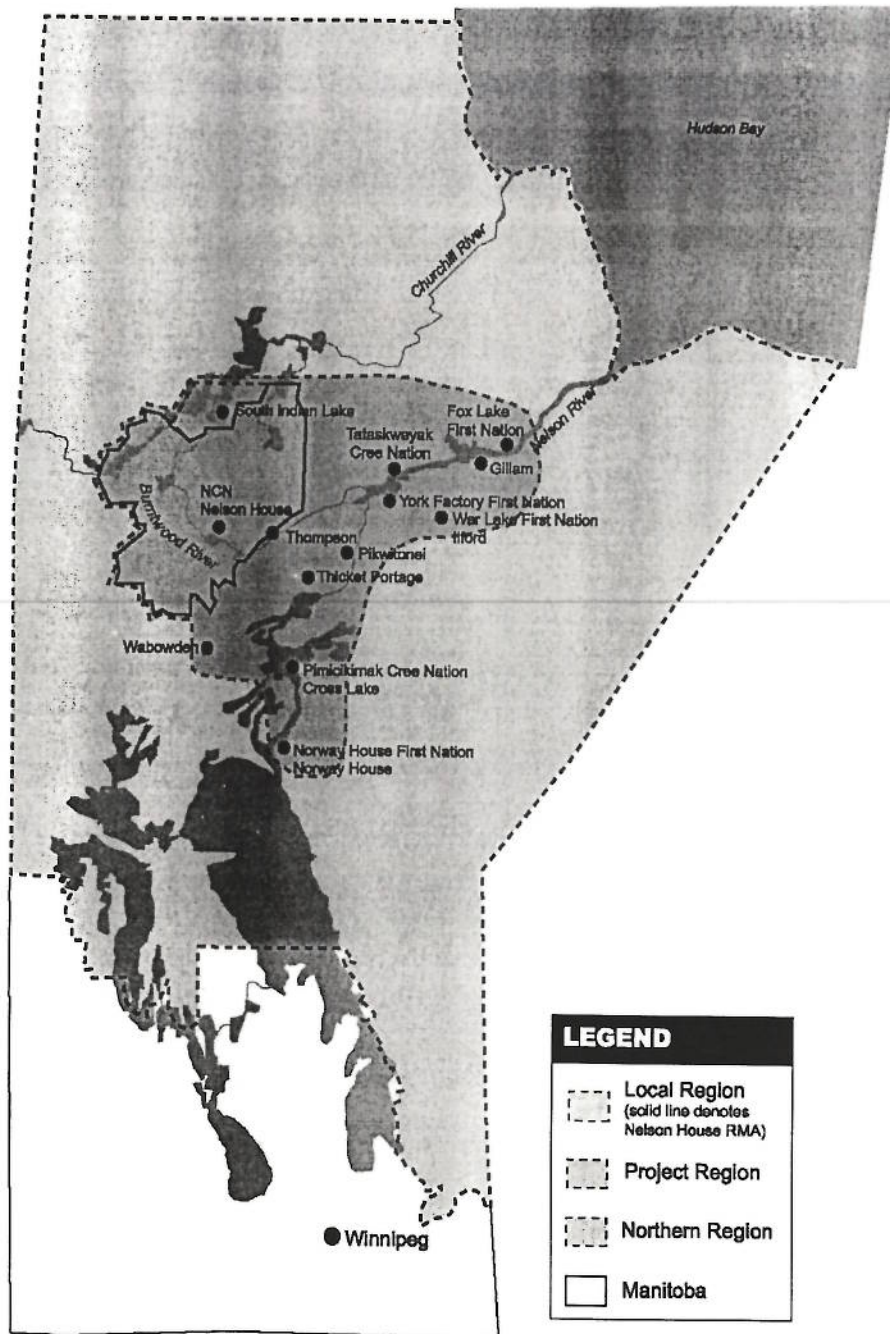

Dear Mr. Baker:

This is in response to your letter of March 10, 2003, concerning your request for independent recognition of the O-Pipon-Na-Piwin Cree Nation as a First Nation under a Section 17 Ministerial Order.

First, let me reiterate my commitment to formally recognize your community as a separate First Nation. Let me also assure you that the resolution of outstanding issues with respect to setting apart the community as a reserve will continue to progress with the utmost expediency. It was my hope that appointing a federal representative to work with you and your technical team would have reaffirmed and emphasized my position on this matter.

I appreciate the sense of urgency that you feel, particularly in light of how long it has taken to achieve progress to date. I also understand the frustrations associated with funding as it currently flows to your community. I must advise that formal recognition of the O-Pipon Na-Piwin Cree Nation as a First Nation will be finalized once the Phase I lands have been transferred and accepted as federal lands and as soon as the federal Order-in-Council to set apart the lands as reserve has been granted.

Regional officials have assured me that they will continue to fast track the Phase I lands through the Additions-to-Reserve process. These activities will proceed while assurances which demonstrate that the Province is fully engaged and committed to resolution of the outstanding issues relative to the Phase II lands are secured, and while the negotiations on the Phase II lands progress toward a resolution.



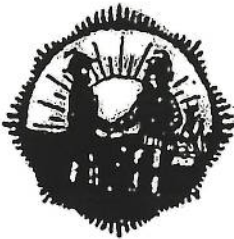

**RE: RECOGNITION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF
SOUTH INDIAN LAKE FIRST NATION AND RESERVE**

During the 16th Annual Manitoba Keewatinowik Okimakanak (MKO) Annual Assembly, held in July of 1997, Nelson House First Nation Chief Jerry Primrose, on behalf of the Nelson House First Nation members living at South Indian Lake, Manitoba, presented a resolution requesting that the MKO Chiefs in Assembly recognize the South Indian Lake First Nation as the 27th member First Nation within the Manitoba Keewatinowik Okimakanak. This resolution was further considered by the MKO Executive Council who provided support for the objectives of the Nelson House First Nation members living at the South Indian Lake community to establish the South Indian Lake First Nation and reserve, and to be recognized as an MKO member First Nation.

Nelson House First Nation members residing at South Indian Lake have been seeking a reserve of their own since at least 1958, when (then) Chief Thomas Linklater of the Nelson House First Nation wrote to the Deputy Minister of the Indian Affairs Branch of the Department of Citizenship and Immigration to request that a reserve be set aside at South Indian Lake. However, the Indian Affairs Branch denied this request, despite the fact that members of the Nelson House First Nation have been living as a community at South Indian Lake since at least 1875, when Treaty No. 5 was entered into by members of the Nelson House First Nation. In addition, the Indian Affairs Branch was aware that the main Nelson House First Nation community at Nelson House, Manitoba (which community was established as a reserve in 1930) and the northern Nelson House First Nation community at South Indian Lake are separated by a distance of 193 kilometres.

Today, the fact that more than 22% of the total population of the Nelson House First Nation resides at South Indian Lake without recognition as a distinct First Nation and without reserve lands has created considerable complications in virtually all aspects of this First Nation's government administration. Almost all federal and provincial government agencies insist on communicating and negotiating directly with the Nelson House First Nation Chief and Council at Nelson House on matters related to the rights, interests and objectives of the South Indian First Nation members, instead of resolving these matters directly with the South Indian Lake First

Nation. Clearly, South Indian Lake is an existing, viable and on-going community both in terms of historic continuity and within the meaning of the *Additions to Reserve Policy* of your Department.

The Chief and Council of the Nelson House First Nation have recognized the membership at South Indian Lake as the South Indian Lake First Nation, and MKO has now recognized the South Indian Lake First Nation as the 27th member MKO First Nation. It now only remains for you and your Department to recognize the South Indian Lake First Nation as a new Band under section 17 of the *Indian Act*, and to set aside reserve lands for the use and benefit of this First Nation.

In support of this objective, I wish to bring to your attention the following developments that have already occurred:

1. the Province of Manitoba, by agreement dated December 22, 1992, agreed to transfer the administration and control of 8500 acres of provincial Crown lands to Canada for designation as reserve lands for the use and benefit of the South Indian Lake First Nation;
2. Article 5 of the Nelson House First Nation Northern Flood Agreement (NFA) Implementation Agreement provides that the Nelson House First Nation may select 2000 acres of provincial Crown land within the Southern Indian Lake Registered Trapline District to be set aside as reserve lands for the South Indian Lake First Nation;
3. South Indian Lake First Nation members, the Nelson House First Nation, Canada and Manitoba entered into a Memorandum of Understanding on April 4, 1995 aimed at the earliest recognition of the South Indian Lake First Nation as a "Band" under the *Indian Act*, and to set aside lands as a reserve at South Indian Lake;
4. the Province of Manitoba has also agreed to transfer all existing infrastructure, buildings and equipment in the present Northern Affairs Community of South Indian Lake to the South Indian Lake First Nation free of any cost to the South Indian Lake First Nation and/or the Nelson House First Nation;
5. under the terms of the recently concluded Treaty Land Entitlement Framework Agreement, the South Indian Lake First Nation is entitled to a per capita share of the land (approximately 18,000 acres) and any other benefits of the Nelson House First Nation; and
6. on October 23, 1995, the Nelson House First Nation Chief and Council passed a Band Council Resolution confirming all of the land entitlements identified at items #1, #2 and #5, above, for a total of some 28,500 acres of land to be set aside as reserve lands for the use and benefit of the South Indian Lake First Nation.

In summary, it is evident that the South Indian Lake First Nation should be immediately recognized by you and your Department as a Band within the meaning of the *Indian Act*, and that reserve lands should be established for the use and benefit of the South Indian Lake First Nation. Such actions by your Department would support

the South Indian Lake First Nation as an existing, viable and on-going community, and would provide for the jurisdiction of the South Indian Lake First Nation government over the affairs of its members.

Recognition of the South Indian Lake First Nation by the Government of Canada, and the designation of reserve lands for this First Nation are long overdue. In conclusion, on behalf of the South Indian Lake First Nation, I am requesting that you and your officials give this matter the attention it deserves.

Good afternoon Chairman Lecuyer, and Commissioners Kinew, Nepinak, Mayer and Sargeant. It has been an interesting journey we have shared since these hearings began on March 2nd.

First, let me recognize the Nisichawaysihk Cree sovereignty within their traditional lands, which are today known as their Resource Management Area. While we respect the Nisichawaysihk Cree Nation's right of self government, their sovereignty, their economic development ambitions, and their right to decide what is best for their future; no one's sovereignty should negatively impact on that of another.

During these hearings, we have taken the opportunity to inform the Commission, and those interested in these proceedings, of our relationship with the proponents. We have also advised you of our concerns with the Environmental Impact Statement, and provided you with a summary of our unique community history, socio-economic situation, and the culture of the O-Pipon-Na-Piwin Cree Nation.

The manner in which Government and Manitoba Hydro have treated our Cree Nation community is certainly not one of the good news stories in Manitoba's history. The bottom line is that we are fully committed to our objectives of having our Cree Nation Government recognized and our long outstanding reserve established, and we are certainly not moving away from South Indian Lake.

We would truly like to redirect the considerable energy we currently expend seeking our formal recognition, to the social and economic development of our community. While we proceed through the final steps of this frustratingly slow process of recognition; we firmly believe that respect for our Cree Nation community should not be a future event that will only start on some magical day when the Minister of Indian Affairs signs his Ministerial Order.

We believe it is time to turn over a new leaf with Manitoba Hydro and develop a new relationship. It is the only way. After all, they are not leaving either, so we shall be neighbours forever. The big challenge is how to go about accomplishing a more positive relationship?

If Manitoba Hydro is sincere with its stated intention to enter into relationships with Northern Cree Nations regarding future hydro development, it is only logical that this begin with the Cree Nation Community that lives on the reservoir, that supplies the water to drive their turbines. If not, the whole approach lacks credibility, and will not become the priceless relationship they hope it to be.

The concept of Cree Nation communities benefiting directly from the profits produced by Hydro developments sure sounds a lot better than their past way of doing business. O-Pipon-Na-Piwin Cree Nation supports economic development.

If Hydro's intention with the Wuskwatim Power Development Agreement is to offer the people of South Indian Lake an opportunity to become business partners; their approach needs to be rethought, because that objective will not be realized through a Manitoba Hydro - Nisichawayasihk Cree Nation partnership.

What has been presented and described is a proposed partnership between Manitoba Hydro and the people of Nelson House. To know in your hearts that our people in South Indian Lake will not realize any of the beneficial effects; but to mask this reality by including South Indian Lake in a Local Region, and then concluding that the beneficial effects will be felt evenly throughout the Local Region, is wrong. It simply adds to our people's mistrust.

So how does the O-Pipon-Na-Piwin Cree turn over a new leaf, and develop a new relationship with Manitoba Hydro?

- Well first, we believe that a new relationship must be built on mutual respect.
- Second, we believe it must recognize the severe harm that the Churchill River Diversion caused to our lake, ecosystem, and people; and take positive action to heal and mitigate the damage. The needs of our environment cannot simply be ignored. That will not result in our people trusting Manitoba Hydro enough to develop a positive future relationship.
- Third, a new relationship must ensure that the future projects do not adversely affect our lives again. This requires proper analysis; not a socio-economic study that essentially ignores our community, and our people's perspectives and culture, by amalgamating us with the proponents and overshadowing our distinct views and concerns.
- Fourth, we believe this relationship must be built directly with our distinct community, not through the leadership of another community over a hundred miles away in a different resource area. We believe a new relationship must recognize and respect the path we are on to independent recognition, and the commitments that Manitoba, Manitoba Hydro, and NCN have made to ensure our formal recognition is finally successful. We believe these commitments should be supported through their current actions, and the current relationship with our community, and not be on hold until some future date.
- Finally, we believe that consultation should be directly with our people. Our people should have an opportunity to consider and make a fully informed independent decision regarding a future development relationship with Manitoba Hydro. Major initiatives and projects relating to our water, people, and lands should respect and support formal independent recognition right now. We believe this is the appropriate manner of proceeding given our unique historical relationship and the principles and understandings that led to the commitments that are currently in place.

This is not the first time we have advised the Governments of this. We have written to and met with; Hydro's President Brennan, Minister Lathlin, Minister Robinson, Minister Nault, Deputy Minister Bostrom, and the Regional Director Generals of Indian Affairs, and always emphasised that only when we are consulted directly and represent ourselves, do we believe that our unique interests are adequately protected.

We are a distinct Cree Nation community, and Canada, Manitoba, Manitoba Hydro, and NCN have previously acknowledged and recognized our path, and committed to use their best efforts to ensure it is successful.

We believe these commitments of the past, should be reflected in the relationships we have today, in order to best accomplish the objectives we mutually agreed to accomplish together.

Our people, who live on the reservoir that drives the Manitoba Hydro turbines all the way down the Burntwood and Nelson Rivers; should be the first people approached and consulted about potentially partnering, and sharing in the equity stream of any development that is powered by the water in our lake. An equity position in Wuskwatim would go a long way toward establishing the new relationship with Manitoba Hydro that I referred to earlier. We should not be further punished due to lack of action by others through no fault of our own; or by Manitoba Hydro policies, which are of course simply policies.

Our current relationships with the Governments and Manitoba Hydro should fully support the goals that have been mutually agreed upon and committed to. In our view, that would be much closer to the commitments to, "use best efforts to ensure the success of the process leading to recognition in an expeditious manner."

We would like to summarize the recommendations we respectfully submitted to this Commission during our presentation:

- 1) Recognition that the O-Pipon-Na-Piwin Cree Nation community of South Indian Lake has unique interests, and these cannot be accurately represented by the proponents who have different interests, aspirations, and goals.
- 2) That Manitoba Hydro's conversion of South Indian Lake into a reservoir means that we will be neighbours forever; and therefore Hydro must develop a relationship with the O-Pipon-Na-Piwin Cree immediately, to add reality to their First Nation partnership strategy.
- 3) Recognition that adverse effects from the Churchill River Diversion are ongoing outstanding business; that needs to be dealt with to protect the Honour of the Crown and their Crown corporations, and to restore the lost trust between Cree Nation communities and the utility.
- 4) That the Augmented Flow Program conditions set out by the Minister of Conservation every year for the past 12 years should be enforced. That is; a) fully mitigate any effects of the altered levels and flows, and b) regulate our lake in such a manner so as to minimize adverse impacts on our people.
- 5) That the O-Pipon-Na-Piwin Cree culture and socio-economic setting in South Indian Lake be accurately portrayed in the Environmental Impact Statement, so that we are able to monitor change and determine effects; especially in relation to our commercial fishery, our other traditional harvesting, and culture. We need this socio-economic base line established, to enable adequate monitoring to follow.

6) That the proposed employment monitoring within the Local Region, needs to separate the effects experienced by South Indian and Nelson House; so that we can precisely analyse the results and determine appropriate follow up action.

7) Recognition that a social and cultural effect of the proposed Wuskwatim project is the further division of communities and families, and increased financial disparity between communities. At present the Environmental Impact Statement does not recognize this effect or analyse it. If the equity cash flow to a community is a significant effect; the social disparity that will be created between communities is a significant adverse effect.

8) That our people should be directly consulted, and have an opportunity to consider and make a fully informed independent decision regarding a future development relationship with Manitoba Hydro. This would include the potential sharing of the equity stream resulting from Manitoba Hydro developments that are powered by the water from our South Indian Lake. We believe this should take place in advance of our formal recognition by the Minister of Indian Affairs, and not be dependent upon implementation of actions committed by the Federal Minister.

Thank you for the opportunity to summarize the views of the O-Pipon-Na-Piwin Cree Nation. We have participated in this CEC hearing process in order to ensure that our independent voices and concerns would be heard clearly. We look forward to your report and recommendations.
