The organization seeks to provide information to fishers, and help make decisions that benefit Keewatinook Fishers.

- the health of Lake Winnipeg,
- the history and culture of the 200 year old Lake Winnipeg First Nation commercial fishery,
- negotiations on behalf of the fishers,
- participation in fishery events & committees,
- operation of the fishery,
- safety on the lake,
- training and education for the Keewatinook Fishers,
- and maintaining and improving economic benefits from the fishery.
